

# Consultation 56: proposed changes in the regulatory documents for transmission

**May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

Fluxys Belgium is proposing adjustments to its access code for transmission with a focus on changes for the subscription and allocation of Services on Dunkirk LNG.

The consultation starts on May 16<sup>th</sup> and ends on June 6<sup>th</sup> 2022 close of business.

## **1. Subscription and allocation of Services on Dunkirk LNG**

In the context of Security of Supply, the current European energy crisis and in order to facilitate the natural gas supply via LNG towards the European Markets, Fluxys Belgium propose to change the subscription and allocation of Entry Services for Dunkirk LNG. The proposal aims to:

- Allow Network Users, who have booked newly subscribed regasification capacity at Dunkirk LNG (max 3,5bcm), to acquire the Entry Dunkirk LNG Services.
- Request the Network users to submit the request for the Services via written during the Call for Market Interest organised by Dunkerque LNG.
- Allocate such Services on a pro-rata basis based on the allocated newly subscribed regasification capacity at Dunkirk LNG of each Network User.

Any remaining Services can be subscribed afterwards on a first come first serve principle via Prisma.

The details of these adjustments are set out in ACT – Attachment B.
