Subject: ENGIE's answer to INTERCONNECTOR's consultation

Dear Sarah,

Please find below our comments on the on going consultation :

ENGIE welcomes INT's proposal to enhance its implicit allocations offer, both in terms of increasing the proportion of INT's technical capacity offered via the IAM, and in terms of reducing the length of the IAM suspension windows. We believe this would favor gas flows and capacity bookings between the UK and the continent and present both shippers and INTERCONNECTOR with more opportunities.

As for the proposal of reducing tariff publication lead times, for short-term capacity via the IAM, and mid-term capacity via Prisma, ENGIE is not in favor of that. In fact, we believe that this would give shippers less visibility and stability of the transmission tariffs and will therefore discourage them from booking more capacity on INTERCONNECTOR.
