**Consultation on Interconnection Agreement between Interconnector Limited and National Grid Gas**

Interconnector Limited (“**Interconnector**” or “**INT**”) would like to hear stakeholder’s views on its proposed changes to the Interconnection Agreement (“**IA**”) with National Grid Gas (“**NGG**”).

This consultation letter outlines a summary of the proposed changes to the IA and the accompanying attachments published on Interconnector’s website detail the specific changes proposed to this document.

**1. Introduction**

The IA describes the operational provisions between INT and NGG, the Transmission System Operators (TSOs), whose systems are connected at the INT Interconnection Point (IP) at Bacton.

**2. Proposed Amendments to the Interconnection Agreement**

Amendments are proposed to update the IA primarily to remove obsolete terms and to reflect current operational practices. Additionally the pressure service terms in Annex B-3 have been updated and the charging arrangements removed to a separate agreement.

The following documents are published alongside this letter for review:

- (i) Proposed Amendment and Restated Interconnection Agreement 2021 – clean version;
- (ii) Proposed Amendment and Restated Interconnection Agreement 2021 – marked up against current 2016 ARIA;
- (iii) Table summarising changes proposed in 2021 ARIA.

For your information, currently two Uniform Network Code (UNC) modification proposals, UNC 0786S and UNC 0787S raised by NGG related to this proposal, are being consulted on by the Joint Office of Gas Transporters.
